SUBJECT: **HEALTH SERVICES ON-LINE TRAINING FOR SCHOOL STAFF**

Student Intervention Services in the Department of Safe Schools has established ongoing trainings to assist school staff that are designated to provide health services within our schools.

There are two new offerings through **TrainU** that school staff in these health service roles should complete to ensure compliance and safety. They are:
