SUBJECT: End of Course Exams (EOC) and EOC Waiver for Students with Disabilities

Students with disabilities are expected to participate in the End of Course Exams. Students with disabilities with an Individual Education Plan (IEP) are eligible for an EOC waiver. The results of the EOC can be waived for the purpose of determining the student's course credit. There are no EOC exams for Exceptional Student Education (ESE)/Access Courses (7000 courses). Students with a 504 Plan are not eligible for the EOC Waiver.

Upon receipt of a student's nonproficient EOC score, the ESE Contact will convene an IEP meeting. During the IEP meeting the team will complete the EOC Assessment Result Waiver, PBSD 2394, to determine if the student met proficiency of the course standards. If the IEP team determines the student has met proficiency of the course standards, a copy of the completed EOC Assessment Result Waiver, PBSD 2394, is provided to the data processor to code the appropriate TERM screens.
